

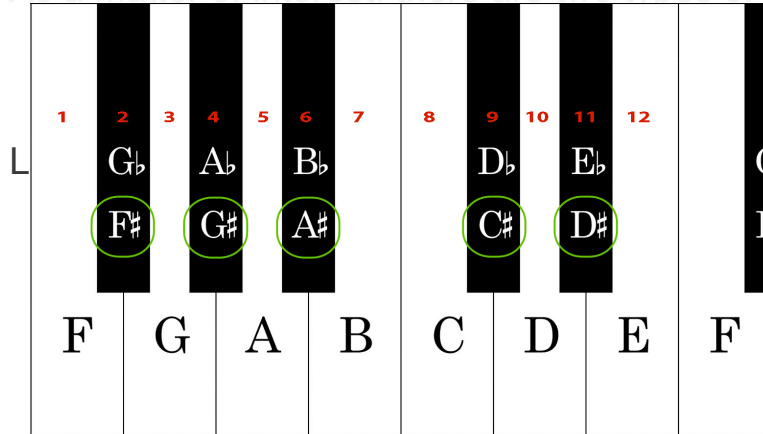
Semitones

A semitone is the distance in pitch between a note and the very next note, higher or lower eg E to F or C to C#.

As a matter of interest, there are two types of semitones:
 1. Chromatic semitone (same name eg C to C#)
 2. Diatonic semitone (different names eg B to C)



This progression takes the A shape up the fret board. Note, you are supposed to barre the chord, but I only hold down 2 strings, as the barring of the rest of the chord is unnecessary (personal choice).
